She teaches music privately and at several local middle schools, and she substitute teaches throughout the Nevada County school district. Cheryl is a member of the music fraternity Sigma Alpha Iota, and also owns Bronze:FX, a music publishing company (www.bronzefx.com). Cheryl and her family live in Grass Valley, CA.

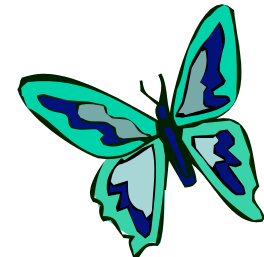

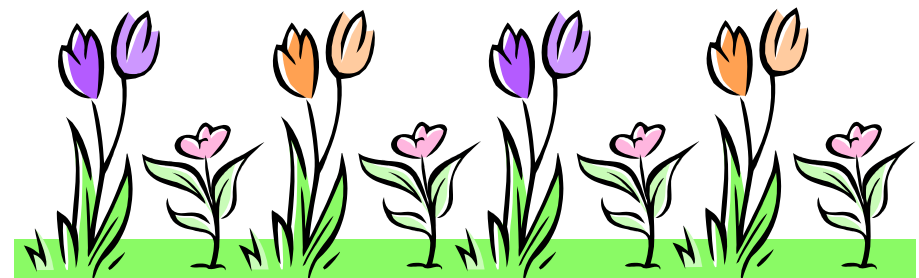
